Good Environmental Choice Australia Ltd. is the standard setting and sustainable consumption market promotions body which develops and declares the ecolabelling standards defining product environmental preference in conformance to ISO 14 024 – International Standard for Third Party Environmental Labelling and Declaration (www.geca.org.au). GECA is an independent non-profit environmental research and ecolabeling standard setting organisation recognised as the Australian member of an international network of ecolabelling schemes under the Global Ecolabelling Network.

Environmental Assurance (also trading as Good Environmental Choice Services Pty Ltd) is the auditing and certification body with responsibility for product assessment, certification and licensing of products against the declared standards (www.eassurance.com.au). GECS is the assessment body for this Program with expertise specific to quality product environmental performance auditing following the principles of ISO 14 010 and ISO 14 024 in it's audit and certification services.

Following an independent audit against the recognition requirements of the Australian Program this declaration outlines key environmental performance attributes of products that have been awarded the "Environmental Choice Australia" label for the Australian market. The Ecolabel is awarded to those products that meet or exceed voluntary standards of environmental performance.

The objectives of the program are to:

- a) Provide incentives for suppliers to reduce the environmental impacts of products sold in Australia;
- b) Provide a clear, credible and independent guide to consumers wishing to take account of environmental factors in their purchasing decisions;

3. KEY ENVIRONMENTAL PERFORMANCE FINDINGS

The key environmental performance criteria against which the Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd products were assessed, and the findings by Environmental Assurance, are provided below.

Criterion	Core Environmental Performance Characteristics
Fitness for Purpose	These nominated Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd products are subject to quality control measures during their manufacturing processes. Tests include tolerance requirements for the paper mix, heating and moisture content and production sample analysis for tear strength and form.
Recycled Content	The recycled content of these nominated Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd products is 100%; this percentage exceeds the minimum requirement as stated for this criterion.
Recyclability Requirements	GECS has confirmed that these nominated Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd products have not been coated or treated in any way that would prevent their recycling.
Fibre Sources	GECS has confirmed that these nominated Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd products are not manufactured from virgin fibre sources.
Emissions Requirements	The AOX, COD and Sulphur emissions of these nominated products has been found to be below the maximum allowable limits as stated for this criterion.
Hazardous Substances	GECS have inspected the surfactant and bleach used for the manufacturing of these products and can confirm compliance with this criterion.
Solvents and Cleaning Agents	GECS have reviewed the agents used for the cleaning of the production equipment of these nominated products and concluded that they meet the requirements of this criterion.
Packaging Requirements	These nominated Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd products are packaged with plastic that has not been halogenated and is able to be recycled in mainstream recovery facilities.
Environmental Regulations	Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd adheres to the relevant environmental legislation and has not been prosecuted for violations to Environmental regulations in the past 24 months.
Labour, Anti-Discrimination and Safety Regulations	Queensland Tissue Products Pty Ltd adheres to the relevant social requirements and workplace regulations. The company has not been prosecuted for violations to labour, anti-discrimination or safety regulations in the past 24 months.
